Dave Feeken was involved in the REALTOR® organization for over 20 years. He served as the Alaska Association of REALTORS® president in 1995 and received REALTOR® of the Year honors from the Association in 1996 and in 2005. He also served as the AAR Industry Issues chair and was instrumental in having the REALTOR® organization be heard in Juneau on legislation that affected private property rights. He served as a National Association of REALTORS® Director from 1997-1999 along with serving on numerous national committees since 1994.

The Scholarship Foundation is a tax-exempt foundation; applicants are encouraged regardless of any affiliation. Recipients are chosen on a non-discriminatory basis without preference for employment or affiliation with any real estate firm, broker, or membership in a professional organization.

- Your contact information to include your brokerage mailing address, your phone number, and your email address;
- Explain why you should be considered for a scholarship;
- Include if you have been a recipient of the Dave Feeken scholarship in the past and what years it was received;
- Describe the course or program for which the scholarship will be used;
- Include a statement in your written application: *I do hereby affirm that the information contained in this application is truthful, accurate and complete;* and

## Guidelines

Any Alaska REALTOR® member in good standing is eligible for a Dave Feeken Scholarship.

Recipients will be chosen without regard to race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status, national origin, age, membership in any organization. Applications will be presented to the trustees without identifications of applicants.

Approved application and proof of course completion MUST be provided in order to receive scholarship funds.

Approved scholarship funds will be awarded after completion of the course applied for.

Scholarships are for tuition only and are limited to one person per calendar, and no more than one course with a beginning date during any calendar year shall be considered. Scholarships will be granted for the course requested and only for such courses that lead to a real estate related professional designation or certification. The officers of the Foundation will determine the dollar amount of the scholarships for a particular course, which may vary from time to time, depending upon the funds available.

The officers include President, Helen Jarratt; Secretary, Terry Bryan; Treasurer, David Somers; and Director Emeritus, Glenda Feeken.
